The GDPR is a new regulation intended to strengthen and unify data protection for all individuals within the European Community.

As a club we obviously hold your personal contact data. In carrying out Footloose business we use this information purely for the benefit of your membership: it is never revealed to any third party.

By business we include the sending out of:

- The quarterly Walks Programme
- The quarterly Newsletter
- Notice of the Annual General Meeting and subsequent Minutes thereof.
- Specific Details of forthcoming events
- Other information which the Committee feels would be of interest to members.

Footloose only holds information on people while they are a member of the club. This is to ensure there is a legal and valid reason for holding the data: it solely relates to Footloose business.
